

FATHER'S DAY CRAFT: LET'S GO FISHING!



MATERIALS

Assorted Construction Paper

500-300AST 50/pack

Foam Sheets - Orange 506-4300RG 10/pack

Elmer's School Glue

640-150 each

Scissors

502-100 each

Paper Plates 9"

115-521 100/pack

Coloured Craft Sticks

704-337 100/pack

Wiggle Eyes

610-<mark>201</mark> 125/pack

Hemp Twine

510-401 116m

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Begin with a blue construction paper and cut out a semi-circle. Using the flat end of the semi circle, cut a wave shape for the water.
- 2. Take your paper plate add glue to one half, and glue the blue water to the plate.
- 3. Take your foam sheet and let the children trace their hand. Cut it out.
- 4. Glue two wiggle eyes to the fish.

 Draw a mouth with a marker.
- 5. Get a piece of twine and cut a 4-5 inch string. Glue one end to the fishing rod.
- 6. Take a colour craft stick and put glue on the back. Glue it on the left side of your plate.
- 7. Glue your fish to the right side of your plate. Glue the string where the mouth is.
- 8. Take a marker and write a message on the plate for Dad.
