



THANKFUL THANKSGIVING TURKEY

INSTRUCTIONS



MATERIALS

Coloured Construction Paper

500-350AST 50 per pack

Coloured Craft Sticks

704-337 100 per pack

Elmer's School Glue

640-150 each

Scissors

502-130 each

Multicultural Foam Sheets

506-449 10 per pack

Marker Classpack

706-436 200 per pack

Wiggle Eyes Assorted

610-201 125 per pack

1. Draw and cut out a 3 inch circle and a 2 inch circle on a piece of brown foam sheet. These will be the body and head of the turkey.
2. Take 2 wiggle eyes and glue it on the turkey's head.
3. Taking an orange construction paper sheet, draw and cut out a small triangle for the beak. Glue it on the head.
4. Draw a bean shape on a red construction paper sheet. This will be the snood of the turkey. Cut it out and glue it above the turkey's beak.
5. Glue the head onto the body.
6. Taking 6 coloured craft sticks and lay them out in a fanned shape. This will be the turkey's tail feathers. Write things/people you are thankful for on each stick.
7. Add glue to the bottom portion of each craft stick, and glue the back of the turkey body on the sticks.
8. Lastly, draw and cut out 2 "L" shapes on the orange construction paper. These will be the turkey legs. Glue them on the bottom of the turkey body.
