

TRICK OR TREAT SURPRISE BOX - HALLOWEEN CRAFT



Is it a trick or is it a treat? Kids/adults will be pleasantly surprised by this little spider when they open the lid to this surprise box. Create multiple boxes to offer a fun guessing game. Will you get the box with the actual treat in it? Or will you be stuck with the trick box? An easy and fun box for the Halloween season! Materials Needed:

- Paper Mache Boxes ([703-972](#))
- Paint ([707-153](#) + [707-154](#))
- Paint Brushes ([621-006](#))
- Pipe Cleaners ([506-000](#))
- Pom Poms or Cotton Balls ([524-618](#))

- Wiggle Eyes ([610-201](#))
- Twine ([511-220](#))



1. If you're using cotton balls, glue together 4 cotton balls to make a larger pom pom. This will act as the body of the spider.
2. Taking 2 pipe cleaners, cut them in half, and then group them together. Twist the bundle in the middle, creating a middle part that will hold the legs together.
3. Add some school glue to the middle part of the legs, and attach it to the bottom of the spider.
4. At about the $\frac{3}{4}$ inch mark, bend the pipe cleaner at each leg 90 degrees, creating the leg joint for the spider to stand on.
5. Taking 2 wiggle eyes, glue them onto the spider's face.
6. Put a little dab of glue on the top of the spider's head. Cut a piece of twine, and attach one end to the top of the head. Leave it to dry.
7. Paint your box with whatever design you like. Leave it to dry.
8. Once your box is dry along with the string for your spider, tape the string to the lid of the box.
